To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Daniel Richards of Washtenaw County Michigan Territory had deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Detroit whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Daniel Richards according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for The North East quarter of South East quarter of Section four of Township One North of Range Seven East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Detroit, Michigan Territory containing forty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Daniel Richards

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Daniel Richards and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Daniel Richards and to his heirs and assigns forever.
